



## Jewish Museologies and the Politics of Display University of Leeds, 13-14 March 2016

As political and social upheavals in and beyond Europe are transforming the meanings of cultural diversity and notions of heritage, a two-day international symposium will explore the critical debates about Jewish museums and museologies, and Jewish presences in non-Jewish museums.

This conference will include panels on current museum developments in and beyond Europe, including new and resurgent museums previously beyond the "Iron Curtain". The event will host two roundtables on international and UK debates around the role and future of Jewish museums and Jewish presences in the museum sphere. Themes discussed and debated will include Europe and migration/mobility; memory and trauma; the role of the object in the virtual age; the politics of display; multiple and layered identities; the role of visitors and communities.
